RESOLUTION AMENDING AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES WITH CHASAN LEYNER & LAMPARELLO, PC

WHEREAS, in April of 2015, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority ("Authority") entered into a professional service agreement with Chasan Leyner & Lamparello, PC (the "Law Firm"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that professional service agreement the Law Firm was to perform legal services necessary to properly represent the Authority in connection to a March 9, 2015 arbitration award against the Authority; and

WHEREAS, due to Law Firm's ongoing services, specifically their representing the Authority in an appeal of the March 9, 2015 arbitration award, the Authority by Resolution No. 16-2016 on February 16, 2016 amended the contract term regarding compensation to increase the cap from \$18,000.00 to \$35,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Law Firm has advised the Authority that there is a need to amend the contract term regarding compensation, increasing the cap from \$35,000 to \$53,100 for the same reason as stated in Paragraph 3 above; and

WHEREAS, a contract for said services may be awarded without competitive bidding as a "professional service" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2(6) and 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i) of the Local Public Contracts Law because the contract is for a service performed by persons authorized by law to practice a recognized profession, whose practice is regulated by law, and the performance of which services requires knowledge of an advanced type in a field of learning acquired by a prolonged formal course of specialized instruction and study.
