AWARD OF CONTRACT – VX-456®

WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "Authority") operates a wastewater treatment facility, located at 30 Wyckoff Avenue in the Borough of Waldwick, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Authority advertised on February 22, 2020 for the furnishing and delivery of VX-456® for a period of two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's technical advisor has reviewed the bid of Evoqua and has found same, in all technical aspects, to be in conformance with the advertised specifications and bid requirements, and as such has recommended that the Authority accept said bid submitted by Evoqua; and

WHEREAS, it has been certified by the Authority's Certifying Financial Officer that there are funds available for the award of this contract to Evoqua; and
