**WHEREAS**, an application has been made to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the “Authority”) by RS Builders, LLC on behalf of the Township of Wyckoff (hereinafter referred to as the “Applicant”) for approval of a proposed sanitary sewer extension to be located at 363 Smith Place in the Township of Wyckoff (hereinafter referred to as the “Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project proposes to provide sanitary sewer service to four (4) proposed single family dwellings in the Township of Wyckoff; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority’s technical advisor has reviewed the application and the documents and drawings submitted in support thereof and, by memorandum dated July 6, 2017 has recommended that the Authority approve the Project, subject to fulfillment of certain terms and conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, finding that when completed, the average daily flow from the Project will be 1,200 gallons per day (gpd) and 4 additional residential EDUs will become tributary to the Authority’s system from the Township of Wyckoff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

3. That all newly constructed sewers be tested for infiltration and exfiltration and that such testing be observed and the results approved by an Authority engineer who has been provided with 2 days notice of such testing;
4. That the Applicant pay for engineering expenses incurred by the Authority for all inspection and testing of the sewers and appurtenances;
5. That the Applicant pay for all Authority application fees, legal fees and other application, administrative, technical or any other expenses relating to review of the Project;
6. That any manholes constructed or modified by reason of this Project be fitted with sewer guards to prevent inflow. All manholes constructed must be installed with all required waterproofing measures, including exterior painting and pipe gasket interlock;
7. That water conserving plumbing fixtures be installed in all new building construction to be serviced by the Project;
8. That the Authority be notified by the Applicant or its designee prior to commencement of sanitary sewer installation;
9. That prior to placing this connection into service, the Applicant must submit to the Authority for approval NJDEP Form WQM-005; and
10. That the Applicant comply with the rules and regulations of the Authority and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and be it



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ENERGY GENERATION  
SERVICES FOR PUBLIC USE ON AN ONLINE AUCTION WEBSITE**

**WHEREAS**, the annual budget for electricity use by the Authority is approximately \$1.3 million; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Unit Electronic Technology Pilot Program and Study Act (P.L. 201c30) provides an exception to New Jersey's Public Bid Law allowing the Authority to forego traditional RFQs when purchasing electricity and to purchase electricity through an online reverse auction process in order to reduce cost; and

**WHEREAS**, The NJ Department of Community Affairs has approved EMEX, LLC of Houston, TX as a vendor to offer its reverse auction platform to NJ local contracting units for the purchase of energy generation services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has previously participated in such auctions and has been purchasing electric power at a fixed price for the past 24 months; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has experienced significant savings during this period, and

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority again plans to utilize the online auction services of EMEX, LLC, an approved vendor pursuant to the Act, waiver number EMEX LLC-1, located at [www.energymarketexchange.com](http://www.energymarketexchange.com); and

**WHEREAS**, the auction will be conducted pursuant to the Act.

**RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority that the staff is authorized to participate in an online reverse auction for the purpose of purchasing electricity from third party suppliers for use by the Authority; and



**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority ("Authority") discovered a 20 foot section of sewage pipe that the Authority uses to service certain member municipalities has disintegrated; and

**WHEREAS**, Authority's Engineer has determined that there is a high risk of this sewage line collapsing if it is not repaired immediately; and

**WHEREAS**, a collapse of this sewage line would threaten the health, safety and welfare of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority's Engineer has thus concluded that an emergency condition exists and recommended that this section of sewage line be repaired immediately; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, as follows:

1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Authority is hereby authorized to immediately solicit quotes and award an emergency contract, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1, to perform the required repairs to the damaged sewage line
3. The Authority is directed to file an "Emergency Procurement Report" with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 30 days of the award of the contract, and to comply with all other requirements set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1.
4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
