WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the Authority) operates a waste water treatment facility located in Waldwick, NJ.

WHEREAS, the wastewater treatment process produces sludge, which is then thickened and incinerated prior to hauling and disposal.

WHEREAS, in case of failure in the thickening process, the Authority's Superintendent recommends entering in into an agreement with Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission (PVSC) for emergency disposal.

WHEREAS, the Authority had entered into an agreement with PVSC on March 30, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Administration requests the renewal of the disposal agreement with PVSC for the purposes of emergency disposal.

WHEREAS, the cost of disposal is \$60.00 per 1,000 gallons.

AUTHORIZATION TO AMEND THE NOT TO EXCEED COST FOR THE PLANNING AND DESIGN OF THE INCINERATOR BLOWER UPGRADE PROJECT (Project #1165)

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-2024, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "Authority") identified a number of firms as qualified to perform engineering services required by the Authority pursuant to a Request for Qualifications for such position; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 14-2024 (the "Original Resolution") dated February 21, 2024, the Authority retained CP Engineering. (The "Engineering Firm") to provide Planning, design, bidding assistance, and construction services for the replacement of an existing Sludge Incinerator Combustion Air Blower (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 14-2024 the Authority established the engineering firm's not-to-exceed to be \$66,800; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Firm has reached the not-to-exceed for the Project and has requested additional funder under proposal #23-202 submitted on May 29, 2024; and

WHEREAS, additional design work is required for the Project due to additional piping, electrical work, etc.; and

WHEREAS, The Authority's Superintendent and the Authority's Engineer recommends the not-to-exceed be increased; and

WHEREAS, the cost of additional work is estimated to be \$48,600 and therefore the Authority wishes to amend the not-to-exceed compensation to the Engineering firm to \$115,400; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Certifying Finance Officer has certified that funds are available to increase the budget for the Engineering Firm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority the following:
