WHEREAS, the Authority and the Borough entered into a non-binding Memorandum of Understanding with the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "Authority") dated September 25, 2013 (the "MOU") which contemplates (1) the Borough becoming a member of the Authority, (2) the Borough and the Authority entering into a service contract and (3) the Authority providing wastewater treatment services to a portion of the Borough pursuant to the service contract; and

WHEREAS, the MOU further contemplates that, prior to entering into a service contract, the Authority and the Borough both will request that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ("NJDEP") designate the Authority as the wastewater management planning agency for the Borough pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)2 and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.13; and

WHEREAS, the designation of the Authority as the wastewater planning agency for the Borough is necessary for the Authority to submit a wastewater management plan to NJDEP for the Borough, as contemplated by the MOU; and
