

AUTHORIZATION TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NO. 8 TO THE INTERIOR ALTERATIONS AT THE SERVICE BUILDING PROJECT

WHEREAS the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the “Authority”) entered into a Contract for the Interior Alterations at the Service Building (“the Project”) with Billy Contracting & Restoration, Inc. (“the Contractor”) on March 17, 2022 in the amount of \$874,000; and

WHEREAS, the Authority approved Change Order No. 1 by Resolution No. 68-2022, Change Order No. 2 by Resolution 69-2022, Change Order No. 3 by Resolution 70-2022, and Change order 4 by Resolution 83-2022 increasing the contract not-to-exceed cost to \$914,520.00; and

WHEREAS, the following modifications have been made to the Project and are more particularly set forth in Change Order No. 8 attached hereto (“the Change Order”):

WHEREAS, the change in cost of the project for the above listed modifications has a net total increase of \$11,660.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority’s Consulting Architect, RSC Architects, has reviewed the Change Order and recommends that the Change Order be approved by the Authority; and

**AUTHORIZATION TO RENEW A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE
BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN LAKES**

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey encourages local units to enter into agreements for the joint provision of municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey authorizes entering into such agreements for shared services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the “Authority”) and the Borough of Franklin Lakes (the “Borough”) had entered into a Shared Services Agreement on June 1, 2022 with a termination date of May 31, 2023 for the Authority to 1) act as the New Jersey Licensed Collection System Operator for the Borough; 2) respond to any and all sewer collection emergencies 24 hours a day, 7 days a week; 3) coordinate all third party repairs of the Collection System; 4) when necessary, coordinate, participate and correspond to any and all NJDEP and USEPA inspections and actions regarding the Borough of Franklin Lakes Sanitary Sewer System; 5) coordinate with the Borough and NJDEP Hotline Calls and correspondence regarding the sanitary Collection System; and 6) the Borough will comply as soon as possible with all NBCUA requests for records, information, data or assistance with regard to the operation of the collection system or compliance with any applicable state or federal regulation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has adopted its Resolution No. 118-23 authorizing entering into a new shared services agreement with the Authority to receive the same services as previously provided; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to enter into this agreement with the Borough for a duration of one (1) year subject to the terms and conditions set forth in said agreement attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority the following:

1. The Authority agrees to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Franklin Lakes for a duration of one (1) year to act as the New Jersey Licensed Sewer Operator for the Borough in addition to other services as outlined above; and
2. The Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Authority be and is hereby authorized on behalf of the Authority to execute the Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Franklin Lakes annexed hereto and made a part thereof.



WITH 34 MAPLE AVENUE, LLC
FOR GORGA PLACE, TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, NEW JERSEY
SEWER CONNECTION (via Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus)**

WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the “NBCUA”) has previously determined the need for and facilitated the construction of sanitary sewer lines within the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus and to accommodate wastewater flow from the Township of Washington (the “Township”); and

WHEREAS, the NBCUA has previously resolved to construct sanitary sewer lines to assist in the collection and disposal of sanitary and other waste waters arising within the boundaries of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus and to accommodate wastewater flow from the Township of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the NBCUA has received a Sewer Connection Application from 34 Maple Avenue, LLC regarding Gorga Place, Township of Washington, New Jersey (proposed new residential development) who is desirous of collaborating with the Township of Washington for the connection to an existing Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus sanitary sewer located Wearimus Road. The proposed connection/extension is designed to provide sanitary sewer service to a proposed six (6) single family residences. The proposed connection will involve constructing approximately 904 linear feet of 8-inch PVC gravity main, twelve (12) manholes, modification of an existing manhole and appurtenances to collect and dispose of sanitary and other wastewater arising within the boundaries of Gorga Place of the Township of Washington and to be received and serviced by the NBCUA. The application for this connection/extension projects an average daily increase in flow of 21,000 gallons per day (GPD). Based on this projection, six (6) additional residential equivalent dwelling unit (“EDU”) will become tributary to the Authority from the Township of Washington, (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the NBCUA Technical Advisor, Samuel N. Brewer submitted a memorandum on April 25, 2023, to the Interim Executive Director and NBCUA’s General Counsel indicating that the Authority currently has sufficient capacity to accept the additional flow from this Project and recommended the approval of the Sewer Connection Application by the Authority;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the NBCUA Chairman, Interim Executive Director and the NBCUA’s General Counsel are authorized to prepare any and all documentation in order to facilitate the sewer connection to service Gorga Place with the Township

of Washington and the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus and to report back to the NBCUA Commissioners on the status of same; and the NBCUA shall be responsible for ensuring the intended construction of sanitary sewer lines shall comply with all laws of the State of New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A 40A:11-1 *et. seq.*, and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The Authority hereby authorizes the approval of the Sewer Connection Application submitted by 34 Maple Avenue, LLC, subject to the following Authority requirements;
2. Construction in conformance with all applicable requirements of the Township of Washington and the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus, where applicable.
3. Inspection and approval of the installation of sewers, appurtenances by the Township of Washington and Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus, where applicable.
4. Observation and approval by the Authority of infiltration/exfiltration testing, with the Authority to receive two (2) days advanced notice prior to the testing of all newly constructed sewers.
5. Reimbursement to the Authority by the applicant for all engineering expenses incurred by the Authority for inspection and final testing of the sewers and appurtenances.
6. Payment to the Authority by the applicant for all Authority application fees, legal fees, and other application, administrative, technical, and other review expenses relating to the project.
7. Any manhole constructed or modified by reason of this project must be fitted with sewer guards.

10. Submission to the Authority for its approval, NJDEP form WQM-005, "Certification for Approval by Local Agency," when the construction of this connection is completed.
11. The Chairman, or his designee, be and hereby is authorized to execute any such documents in connection the Sewer Connection Application.
12. The Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority shall be responsible for ensuring that all the construction of sanitary sewer lines comply with all laws of the State of New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A 40A:11-1 et. seq., and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.
