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**PROPOSED SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION  
359 SICOMAC AVENUE  
TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF, NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, an application has been made to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Authority") by McNally, Doolittle Engineering, LLC on behalf of the Township of Wyckoff (hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant") for approval of a proposed sanitary sewer extension to be located at 359 Sicomac Avenue in the Township of Wyckoff, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Project is designed to provide sanitary sewer service initially to three (3) single family homes and one (1) restaurant and future connections of up to six (6) additional single family homes; and

**WHEREAS**, finding that when completed, the projected average daily flow from the Project will be 9,810 gallons per day (gpd) and nine (9) additional residential EDUs and twenty-five (25) additional non-residential EDUs will become tributary to the Authority's system from the Township of Wyckoff; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority's technical advisor has reviewed the application, documents and drawings submitted in support thereof and, by memorandum dated July 30, 2021 has recommended that the Authority approve the Project, subject to fulfillment of certain terms and conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has sufficient capacity to accept the additional flow generated from this Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, that the application made by McNally, Doolittle Engineering, LLC on behalf of the Township of Wyckoff for a sanitary sewer extension to be located at 359 Sicomac Avenue in the Township of Wyckoff, New Jersey be approved upon the condition that the Applicant, its principals, agents, successors or assigns fulfill the following terms and conditions:

1. The construction shall conform to all applicable requirements of the Township of Wyckoff, where applicable;

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2. The installation of the sewers and appurtenances be inspected and approved by the Township of Wyckoff, where applicable;
3. That all newly constructed sewers be tested for infiltration and exfiltration and that such testing be observed and the results approved by an Authority engineer who has been provided with 2 days' notice of such testing;
4. That the Applicant pay for engineering expenses incurred by the Authority for all inspection and testing of the sewers and appurtenances;
5. That the Applicant pay for all Authority application fees, legal fees and other application, administrative, technical or any other expenses relating to review of the Project;
6. That any manholes constructed or modified by reason of this Project be fitted with sewer guards to prevent inflow. All manholes constructed must be installed with all required waterproofing measures, including exterior painting and pipe gasket interlock;
7. That water conserving plumbing fixtures be installed in all new building construction to be serviced by the Project;
8. That the Authority be notified by the Applicant or its designee prior to commencement of sanitary sewer installation;
9. That prior to placing this connection into service, the Applicant must submit to the Authority for approval NJDEP Form WQM-005; and
10. That the Applicant comply with the rules and regulations of the Authority and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that upon written assurance of fulfillment by the Applicant of the foregoing terms and conditions, the Authority Superintendent be and is herewith authorized on

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behalf of the Authority to execute such approvals of the Project as may be required by governmental agencies having jurisdiction thereover.

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**PROPOSED SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION  
1 FRANKLIN TURNPIKE  
BOROUGH OF WALDWICK, NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, an application has been made to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Authority") by Patmark Management Group, LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant") for approval of a proposed sanitary sewer extension to be located at 1 Franklin Turnpike, Borough of Waldwick, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Project is designed to provide sanitary sewer service to a proposed townhome development consisting of eleven (11) residential townhomes which will replace the present structure at the property which is a mixed-use two-story building; and

**WHEREAS**, finding that when completed, the projected average daily flow from the Project will be 2,550 gallons per day (gpd), which is an increase of 1,946 gallons per day from the property's previous average flow of 604 gallons per day; and

**WHEREAS**, ten (10) additional residential EDUs will become tributary to the Authority's system from the Borough of Waldwick; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority's technical advisor has reviewed the application, documents and drawings submitted in support thereof and, by memorandum dated August 16, 2021 has recommended that the Authority approve the Project, subject to fulfillment of certain terms and conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has sufficient capacity to accept the additional flow generated from this Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, that the application made by Patmark Management Group, LLC for a sanitary sewer extension to be located at 1 Franklin Turnpike in the Borough of Waldwick, New Jersey be approved upon the condition that the Applicant, its principals, agents, successors or assigns fulfill the following terms and conditions:

5. That the Applicant pay for all Authority application fees, legal fees and other application, administrative, technical or any other expenses relating to review of the Project;
6. That any manholes constructed or modified by reason of this Project be fitted with sewer guards to prevent inflow. All manholes constructed must be installed with all required waterproofing measures, including exterior painting and pipe gasket interlock;
