### AUTHORIZATION TO ADJUST CONNECTION FEE

**WHEREAS**, after a public hearing on December 6, 2006, as set forth in the Resolution adopted on said date, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "Authority") determined that it would be in the best interest of the public and the local government units it serves to institute a connection fee program in the manner prescribed by N.J.S.A. 40:14B-23, and to adopt the necessary amendments to the Authority's Rules, Regulations and Standards required to implement the connection fee program; and

**WHEREAS**, at the hearing on May 21, 2019, the Authority determined that the cost of the connection fee for the year 2019 would be \$5,833 per service unit as calculated in the 2019 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study prepared by Ferraioli, Wielkotz, Cerullo & Cuva, PA; and

**WHEREAS**, the firm of Wielkotz & Company, LLC, the auditor for the Authority, has prepared a report entitled "2020 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update" for the Authority, with the assistance of the Authority staff, on the proper amount for a connection fee payable by an individual or party making a new connection to the System for the year 2020, in accordance with the formula set forth in N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22, for the privilege of making the connection ("2020 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update"); and

**WHEREAS**, on June 16, 2020, in accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22, the Authority conducted a public hearing on the proposed adjustment of the connection fee prescribed by N.J.S.A. 40:14B-23; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority, having considered, at the public hearing held on June 16, 2020: (i) 2020 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update; and (ii) the statements of those attending the public hearing; and has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Authority to adopt an adjustment to the connection fee charge implemented for the year 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority has determined that the cost of the connection fee will be \$5,797 per service unit as calculated in the 2020 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, as follows:

1. The Authority hereby establishes an adjustment to the connection fee of \$5,797 per service unit as calculated in the 2020 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update, effective as of the date of this Resolution, June 16, 2020, until amended.
2. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary for the implementation of the adjustment of the connection fee.

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE NORTHWEST BERGEN COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING STIPEND AND LICENSE INCENTIVE PAYMENTS TO SUPERVISORY EMPLOYEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Authority encourages all employees to obtain licenses and pursue trades that benefit the Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, several supervisory employees possess licenses and/or have provided services in a skilled trade that confer benefits on the Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority's Superintendent has recommended license incentive and stipend payments for all of the supervisory employees that possess licenses and/or have provided services in a skilled trade that confer benefits on the Authority; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Authority's Board of Commissioners, that:

1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Authority is hereby authorized to pay Robert Genetelli a license incentive of \$6,000 for holding a S4/C4 license.
3. The Authority is hereby authorized to pay Nicholas Fabbriatore a license incentive of \$6,000 for holding a S4/C4 license.
4. The Authority is hereby authorized to pay Edwin Walker a license and trade incentive of \$4,500 for holding a C4 license, Commercial Driver's License and Backflow Preventer Certification.
5. The Authority is hereby authorized to pay Alexander Lerch a license incentive of \$1,500 for holding a S1/C1 license.
6. The Authority is hereby authorized to pay William Eletto a trade stipend of \$1,000 for his Backflow Preventer Certification.
7. The Authority is hereby authorized to pay Andrew Agugliaro a stipend of \$1,500 for his TV Camera Truck/PACP certification and Commercial Driver's License.

**RESOLUTION INCREASING THE BID THRESHOLD  
PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A.40A:11-3 AND N.J.A.C.5:34-5.4**

**WHEREAS**, the recent changes to the Local Public Contracts Law gave local contracting units the ability to increase their bid threshold from \$40,000 to \$44,000 effective July 1, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the quotation threshold for local units with Qualified Purchasing Agents, is fifteen percent (15%) of the bid threshold, which increases the new quotation threshold from \$6,000 to \$6,600; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3 permits an increase in the bid threshold if a qualified Purchasing Agent is appointed as well as granted the authorization to negotiate and award such contracts below the bid threshold; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert Genetelli was appointed on March 2, 2010 by Resolution No. 22-2010 as the Qualified Purchasing Agent for the Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority desires to take advantage of the increased bid threshold.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority the following:

1. The governing body of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, in the County of Bergen, in the State of New Jersey hereby increases its bid threshold to \$44,000 effective July 1, 2020; and
2. The local unit Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
