WHEREAS, on April 7, 2021, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority ("Authority') experienced during NIRO Incinerator startup, a breach of the inlet piping above the venturi scrubber causing hot ash to exit the incinerator; and

WHEREAS, the venturi scrubber malfunctioned causing scrubber water to enter the heat exchanger; and

WHEREAS, the backup incinerator was offline for maintenance and not readily available; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Superintendent has determined as a result of the malfunction that the Authority needs to manage solids inventory by means of transporting solids off-site for the purpose of maintaining operations; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Superintendent has thus concluded that an emergency condition exists and recommended that transportation be secured to remove solids offsite to help maintain operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, as follows:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

- That any manholes constructed or modified by reason of this Project be fitted with sewer guards to prevent inflow. All manholes constructed must be installed with all required waterproofing measures, including exterior painting and pipe gasket interlock;
- 7. That water conserving plumbing fixtures be installed in all new building construction to be serviced by the Project;
- 8. That the Authority be notified by the Applicant or its designee prior to commencement of sanitary sewer installation;
- That prior to placing this connection into service, the Applicant must submit to the Authority for approval NJDEP Form WQM-005; and
- 10. That the Applicant comply with the rules and regulations of the Authority and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and be it
