WHEREAS, the firm of Wielkotz & Company, LLC, the auditor for the Authority, has prepared a report entitled "2023 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update" (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Report") for the Authority, with the assistance of the Authority staff, on the proper amount for a connection fee payable by an individual or party making a new connection to the System for the year 2023, in accordance with the formula set forth in N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22, for the privilege of making the connection ("2023 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update"); and

WHEREAS, the connection fee per service unit as calculated in the Report is \$5,491; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2023, in accordance with the requirements of <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:14B-22, the Authority conducted a public hearing on the proposed adjustment of the connection fee prescribed by <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:14B-23; and

WHEREAS, the Authority, having considered, at the public hearing held on June 21,2023: (i) 2023 Sewer Connection Fee Rate Study Update; and (ii) the statements of those attending the public hearing; and has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Authority to adopt an adjustment to the connection fee charge implemented for the year 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that the cost of the connection fee will be \$5,491 per service unit for 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, as follows:

- 1. The Authority hereby establishes an adjustment to the connection fee of \$5,491 per service unit for 2023, effective as of the date of this Resolution, July 19, 2023, until amended.
